
Department of Commerce








Department of English

Mrs.B.Joyce, HOD, Dept.of Chemistry shared her experiences with the parent community, regarding curricular and co-curricular activities.







On the next day, they visited Mahabalipuram, the Shore Temple in Madras. After spending a lot of time on shopping the trip ended joyfully.




