#### Academics::

Commencement of Regular Academic Year : UG-(I,III &V- Semesters) & PG-(I & III- Semesters)-October-2022 to February 2023.

The Academic Year 2022-2023 had commenced from 17<sup>th</sup>October 2022 for First Year I Semester, 25<sup>th</sup> October 2022 for Second Year 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester and 1<sup>st</sup> November 2022 for Final Year- V Semester UG programmes.

For First Year - I Semester P.G Courses for the Academic Year started from 31<sup>st</sup> October 2022 & Second Year - III Semester commenced from 18<sup>th</sup> October 2022.

As per APSCHE instructions, Semester Internship (Long Term) with six months duration was introduced for Final B.Com and BCA students (Academic Batch of 2020 -21) in Fifth Semester and it was implemented from 1st November 2022 onwards. Regarding this, B.Com students were enrolled in Tally - Organization named as Nitya Computer Accounting Training with the role as Accountant .Classes were taken via Off Line Mode in College Campus presented by the Resource Person Mr.P. Anantha Srinivasa Rao from APSCHE and BCA students were enrolled in Multi Media – Red Carpet Solutions as a role Digital Marketing and classes taken by Off Line Mode in College Campus by the Resource Person Mr. P.Chandra Sekhar from APSCHE.

The Second Term of this Academic Year 2022-2023 had commenced from1<sup>st</sup> March 2023 for Second Year – Fourth Semester, Final Year- Sixth Semester regular Classes for B. Com & BCA programmes. First Year – Second Semester of UG Courses i.e for B.Sc, BCA & B.Com students were commenced from 9<sup>th</sup>March 2023 onwards.

As per the notice of APSCHE, Long Term Semester Internship of the Academic Batch 2020-21 was commenced from  $6^{\text{th}}$  April 2023 for B.Sc Course - Biotechnology students on "Fermentation Technology", Microbiology students on "Isolation of Microbes from different sources", Botany students on 'Plant Tissue Culture" and Chemistry students on Green Chemistry Nanoparticles" in collaboration with Pearls Lab.

For III MPC, MPCS, MSCS students on "Python Programme" via off line, classes were conducted in College Seminar Hall by appointed Resource person by APSCHE, Mr.Siva Kumar from Campus Glue Development & Software Solutions, Guntur. The classes were going to be ended by 25th June 2023.

For First Year MCA & MBA - II Semester classes commenced from 9<sup>th</sup> March 2023 & II MBA -IV Semester Commenced from 13<sup>th</sup> February 2023.

A Parents Meet with welcome programme was organized for the newly joined 1styear UG students and their parents.
